Directions from south of Grand Junction:

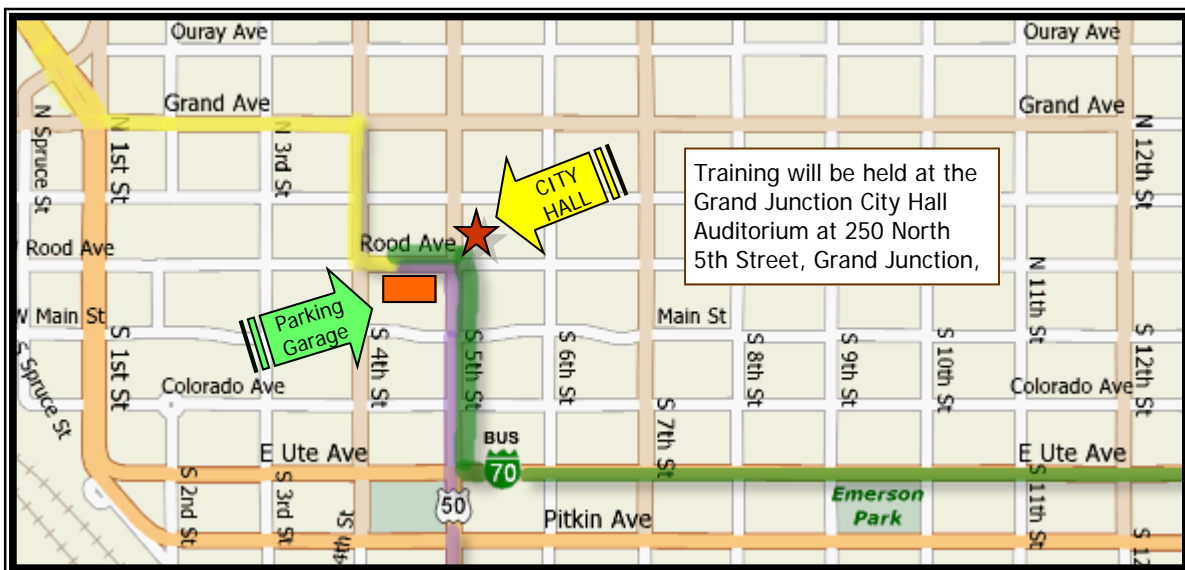
- North bound on US Highway 50, you will enter downtown Grand Junction after crossing the Colorado River. At which point Hwy. 50 turns into 5th Street.
- Turn left onto Rood Avenue and the parking garage will be on the left.
- Grand Junction City Hall is located on the corner of 5th and Rood Avenues. Please use the City Hall west entrance on 5th Avenue.

Directions from west of Grand Junction:

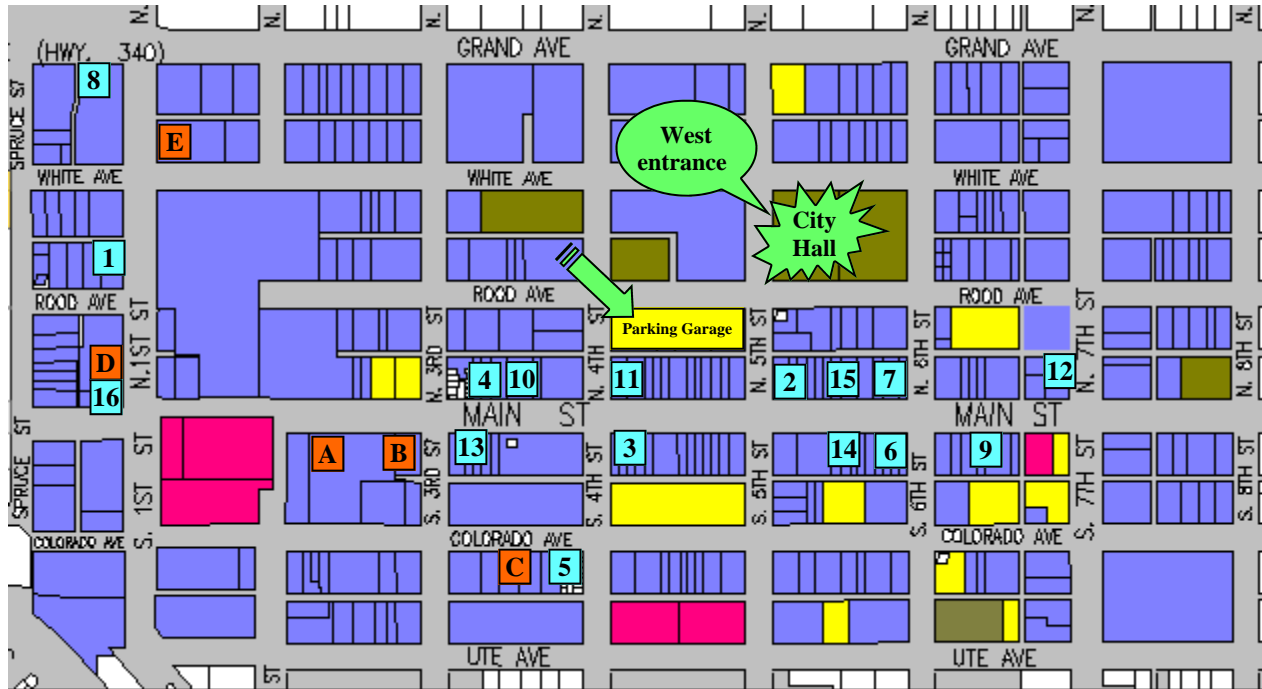
- East bound on I-70 merge onto I-70 Business Loop Exit 26 toward Grand Junction continuing southeast on I-70 Business Loop, going past the left-side exit to North Avenue to Grand Avenue (approximately 5 miles).
- Turn left onto Grand Avenue.
- Turn right onto 4th Street.
- Turn left onto Rood Avenue. The parking garage will be on your right.
- Grand Junction City Hall is located on the corner of 5th and Rood Avenues. Please use the City Hall west entrance on 5th Avenue.

Directions from east of Grand Junction:

- West bound on I-70 merge onto I-70 Business Loop Exit 37 toward Clifton/US-6/Grand Junction.
- Remain I-70 Business Loop as it turns into a one-way street named Ute Avenue to 5th Street (approximately 8 miles).
- Turn right onto 5th Street.
- Turn left onto Rood Avenue and the parking garage will be on the left.
- Grand Junction City Hall is located on the corner of 5th and Rood Avenues. Please use the City Hall west entrance on 5th Avenue.
